



Planning before the works

- Appropriate wood and construction may help you to significantly reduce the use of wood protection coatings.
- Only buy the quantities that you actually need. Most brands offer their products in various packaging sizes. This will prevent unnecessary waste as paints and lacquers have a limited storage time. Some brands propose programs on their web site that help you determine the impact of colors in the rooms. You will also find valuable information as to the choice of the right brush for instance.



Chosing the right products

- For your protection and health use only paints, lacques and wood coatings indoors that are actually designed for this.
- For handcraft and leisure use, hazard free products are available for almost every purpose, made out of vegetable or mineral raw substances. Many paints used by children, i.e. finger paint, chalk, glass paint or plasticine are of short duration and can therefore be produced almost entirely out of natural material: mineral soil or plant extracts as coloring substances, cellulose glue as binding substance and water as solvent.
- Use wall paint with high covering power, which may avoid a second lawyer.
- Lacquers based on solvents are highly contaminative to the air while drying. Only use water based products for indoor applications.
- When buying paints and lacquers for indoor use, check out for the indication „Clever akafen – Products recommended by the SuperDrecksKëscht®“. These products are tested as to their components (heavy metal, “VOC” part, formaldehyde concentration). Furthermore these products have to provide a covering power of at least 7 m² per liter and be available in different packaging sizes.

After the work

- During and after the painting works and drying, keep rooms open and ventilated in order to eliminate possible hazardous substances.
- Paint remains will last longer if kept in well-closed containers turned upside down. This prevents thickening of the surface.
- Paint and lacquer waste is mostly more or less important quantities of remains and packaging containers. These containers can mostly be recycled. Take the empty containers and contaminated waste (brush, rolls) to the SuperDrecksKëscht® (Recycling site or mobile collection site).
